- If you have extra rakes, pruners, paper towels, window cleaner, paint brushes, people, etc. that you would be willing to bring that would be great! The extra items may help your projects run smoother and allow you to complete them quicker.
- REMINDER: Teams that have raking or pruning projects will need to bag and take the leaves/debris to the project recipient's regular pick-up area. We do not have a volunteer team disposing of debris; it is the homeowner's responsibility.
- Remind homeowners not to add extra projects (unless you want to do them) because you need to move to your next project in a timely manner.
- Please exercise caution. We do not want volunteers climbing tall extension ladders or performing tasks you are not comfortable performing or you feel needs to be done by a professional.
